- (E) As National Coordinator of MEITI, Renaissance Institute has to perform MEITI-MSG Coordination Office in order to streamline the implementation of MEITI-MSG activities, to coordinate MEITI-MSG process and to help support the functions of MEITI-MSG chairman according to Notification Order (115/2016) dated 19 December.
